Background

eCourse in Effective Grant writing in Public health is a three-month eLearning program designed to develop expertise in intricacies of grant writing in the field of public health. The course has been developed by Indian Institute of Public Health Gandhinagar (IIPHG). It will be delivered by a multidisciplinary team from IIPHG and experts in the field.

Target audience/ Eligible Candidates

Members of Academia from various Universities, Medical Colleges, Public Health Schools and other Colleges, Members of non-profit organizations, Researchers, Consultants, Corporate organizations and students of various streams who want to learn how to write effective grant proposals.

Aim and purpose

The course will provide detailed description of how an individual/organization can successfully apply for grants from national and international agencies. The course will provide a broad framework for participants to learn how to write a successful proposal. Course will also assist participants to learn skills to arrive at specific research/program goals within the desired time frame.

The course will provide understanding of various grant writing terms, potential sources for grant writing and generic grant writing guidelines. Curriculum includes training for development of a grant proposal and concept note in a structured manner. Content of the course also provide basic understanding of developing activity based budget for grants.

Mode of Delivery

This is a three month ecourse offered in eLearning mode. The program will be based on a combination of online lectures (asynchronous), electronically submitted assignments, recommended readings and interaction with faculty as and when required.
