Course Outline

In global health, Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) like heart disease, high blood pressure, diabetes, cancer, lung diseases, and obesity pose a serious but often unnoticed threat. These chronic conditions silently affect people everywhere, regardless of age or location, from big cities to small villages.

Understanding how genetics, lifestyle choices, and environmental factors contribute to illness is crucial. Empowering individuals and communities with knowledge and resources to take control of their health outcomes leads to informed decisions and collaborative action, paving the road for better health and longevity.

The Public Health Foundation of India has developed an eLearning course on NCDs. This course provides in-depth information on lifestyle choices, the link between mental health and NCDs. It explores preventive strategies, early detection, and policy advocacy. Additionally, it sheds light on emerging trends in NCDs and shares inspiring stories of local heroes fighting against these diseases.

Who Should Enroll ?

Course Design and Duration

The course spans three months and is self-paced. It includes seven modules each lasting approximately one hour. Each module features videos, interactive activities, quizzes, and additional reading material to enrich your learning experience.

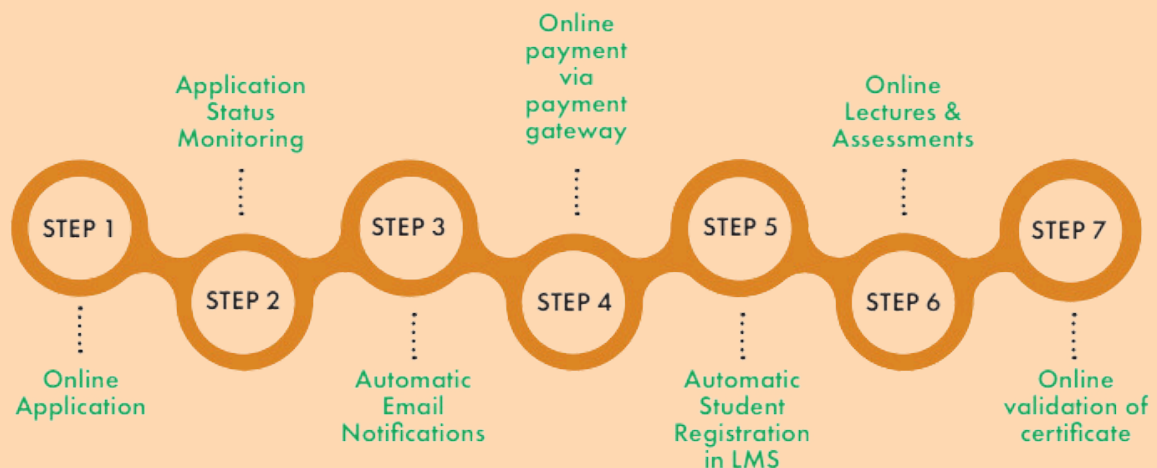
