# Background

eCourse in One Health Approach for Pandemic Preparedness (OHAPP) is a three-month eLearning program designed to cover basic concepts of One Health, and its various implications for the pandemic Preparedness. This course has been developed by the Centre for One Health Education, Research and Development (COHERD), Indian Institute of Public Health Gandhinagar (IIPHG).

COHERD is a collaborative centre established by the Indian Institute of Public Health Gandhinagar (IIPHG), India and the Global Health section of the Institute of Hygiene & Public Health (IHPH) Bonn, Germany. It is a designated centre for excellence striving to work on interdisciplinary topics of One Health. Within the broad field of One Health, the key focus of the centre is on zoonotic diseases, antimicrobial resistance, health system strengthening, disease surveillance, and biosecurity in South and East Asia. This course will be delivered by a multi-disciplinary Global One Health experts both from India and abroad.

## Aim and Purpose

- To develop an understanding of the interdisciplinary nature of One Health concept and its history.
- To explain One Health's role in preventing and preparing for a pandemic of emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases.
- To explain risk factors at the human-animal-environment interface for emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases.
- To understand the various aspects of pandemic preparedness and Global Health security.
- To understand the concept of effective interdisciplinary communication, leadership, intersectoral collaboration and teamwork from One Health perspective in pandemic preparedness

## Eligible Candidates

This multi-disciplinary course is open for students, practitioners, and researchers. Interested candidates from the disciplines of public health, medical and paramedical, veterinary, agriculture, environmental science, life science, developmental studies or related disciplines.
